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Information Sheet: Transition DTMIH to MSc IH

This sheet provides information regarding the transfer from the Diploma in Tropical Medicine and International Health (DTMIH) at the Teaching & Training Unit (T&TU), Division of Infectious Diseases and Tropical Medicine to the Master of Science in International Health (MSc IH) at the Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität, LMU Munich:

MSc IH Application and Admission Requirements for DTMIH Graduates

The general admission requirements and application process, as indicated on the [MSc IH website](#), apply. DTMIH-specific information and required documentation are as follows:

DTMIH Certificate for Recognition of Prior Learning

Applicants who have previously completed the DTMIH at the T&TU have to submit the following documents for recognition of DTMIH course content and examinations to the MSc in International Health:

- DTMIH Certificate and Exam Results
- DTMIH Curriculum

MSc IH Course Fee Structure for DTMIH Graduates

Fee	Costs in €
Tuition fee for semester 1* if the DTMIH has been previously completed at the T&TU	2500
Tuition fee for semester 2*	6000
LMU administration fee per semester	approx. 130

*Please note that the tuition fee covers only Advanced Modules that are offered by the LMU Munich. For the Advanced Modules in Nepal and Ghana, only the course fee will be covered and all other expenses (visa, travel, accommodation etc.) need to be paid by the student.

Attendance Requirements during Semester 1 (October – March)

This only applies to MSc IH students who have previously completed the DTMIH course at the T&TU

Date	Content
October	Attendance during the first week of October: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Induction session• Enrolment appointment at the LMU Munich
January	1 Week at the beginning of January to cover "Research Design" module content in individual sessions
End of February	MSc Project Presentation (examination for "Research Design")
January – March	Attendance at the selected Advanced Modules (usually 1 – 2 weeks per Advanced Module)

DTMIH graduates that are intending to apply for the MSc in International Health at the T&TU should note that application procedures apply as for other applicants. Having previously obtained a DTMIH from the T&TU does therefore not automatically grant admission to the MSc program. It should also be noted that the offer "Transition DTMIH to MSc" is only open for 12 months following the award of the DTMIH certificate (time: from date of awarded certificate to MSc application). After that, full regulations for admission to the MSc in International Health at the T&TU apply.
